



Deploying the Business User Portal on Tomcat


1. Go into the WAR folder of the installation
2. Copy the “BusinessUserPortal.war” file
3. Go into the webapps folder of Tomcat directory and paste the “BusinessUserPortal.war” file into this webapps folder
4. Wait a few minutes (2-3 min). You will see a newly created “BusinessUserPortal” folder.





5. Go into the BusinessUserPortal/WEB-INF/Database folder to configure the “*database.properties*” file
6. Provide the required parameters to connect to the SQL Server/ORACLE database and save the changes

NOTE*: Please Use the AMM Database connection parameters and update the database.properties file.**

7. Set PasswordEncrypted=false and Restart the Tomcat server

IMPORTANT*:** Restart the Tomcat server after updating the “database.properties” file

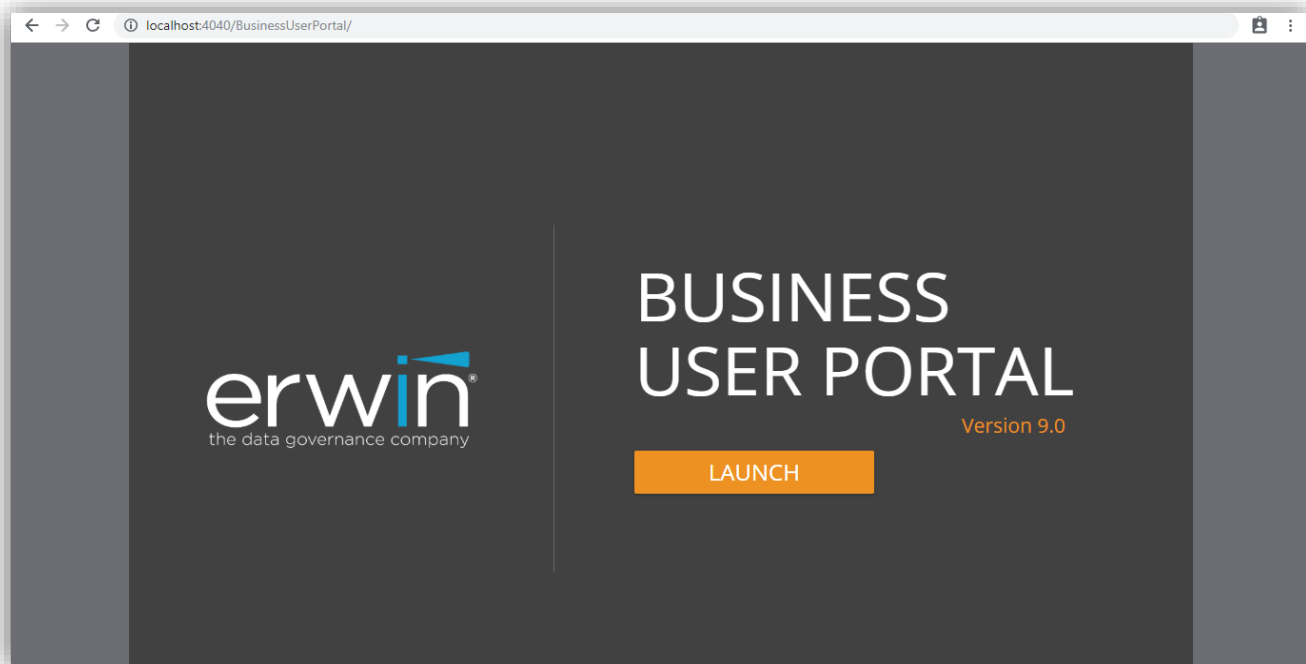
Access the erwin Business User Portal Login Screen
